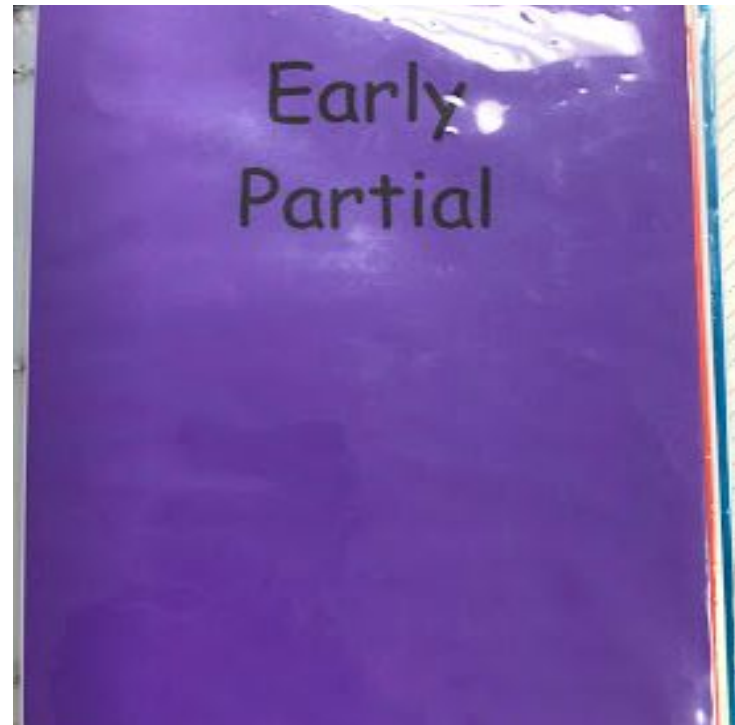
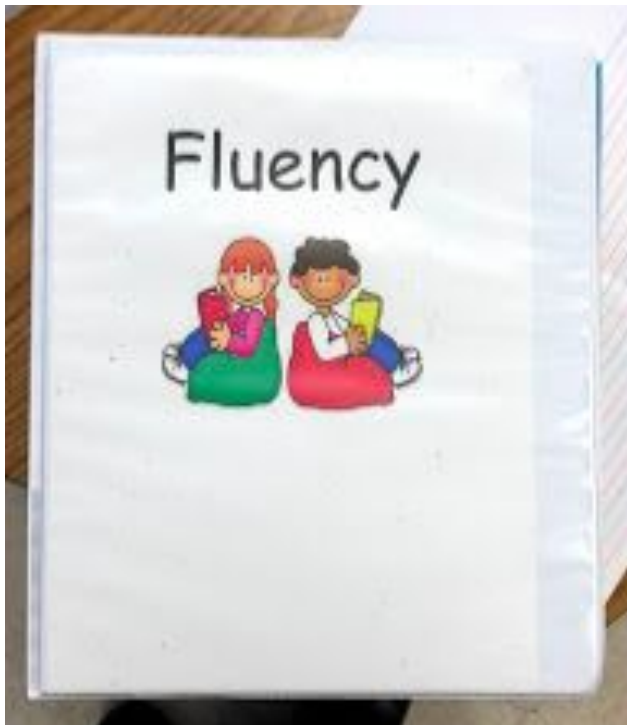

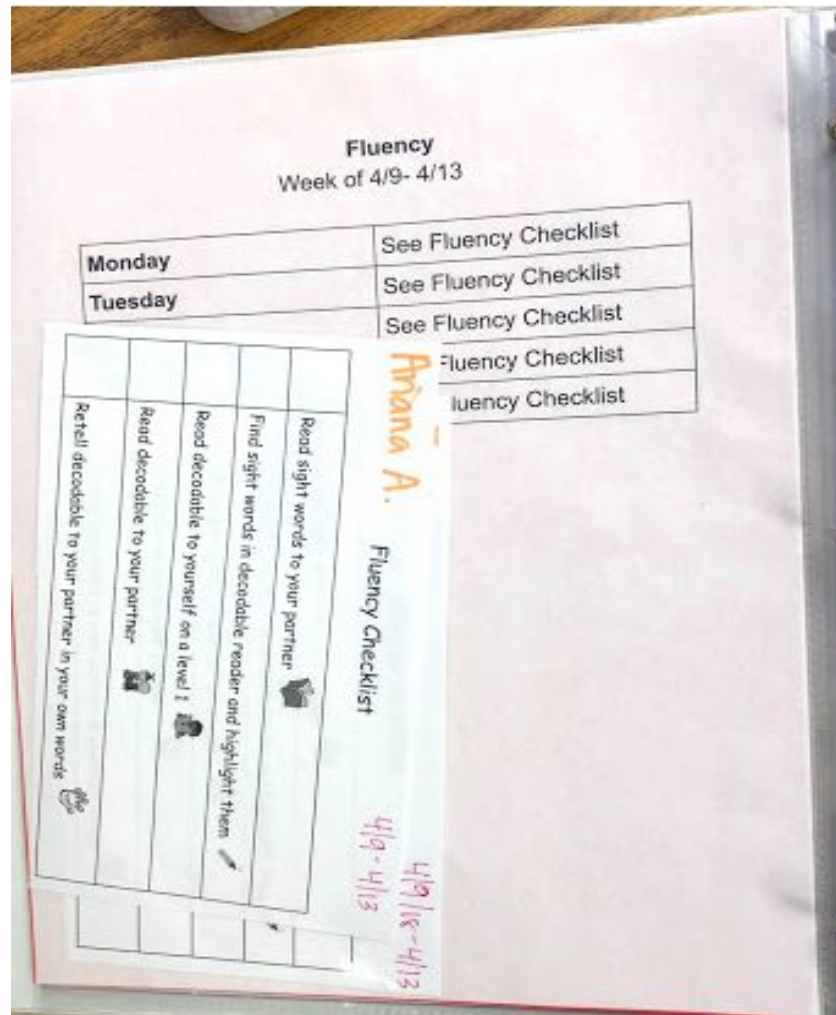

This Fluency binder (and all of the binders in upcoming slides) includes color-coded dividers for each microphase.



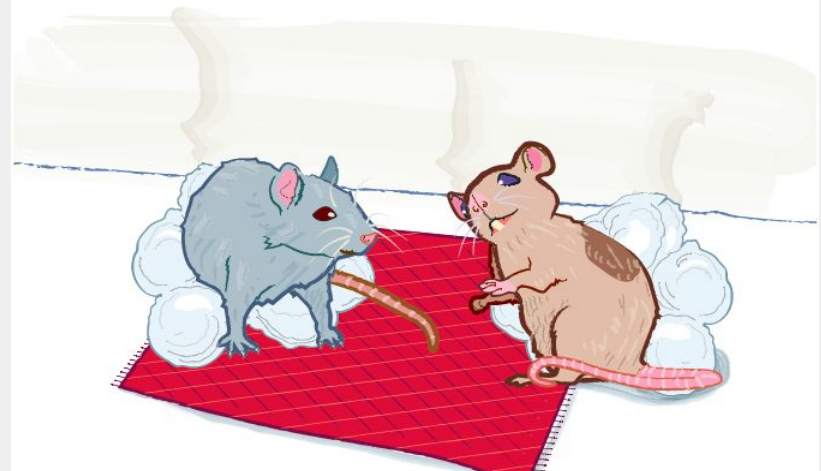
Each student (grouped by microphase within the binder) has his or her own Fluency Checklist to use with a fluency text.



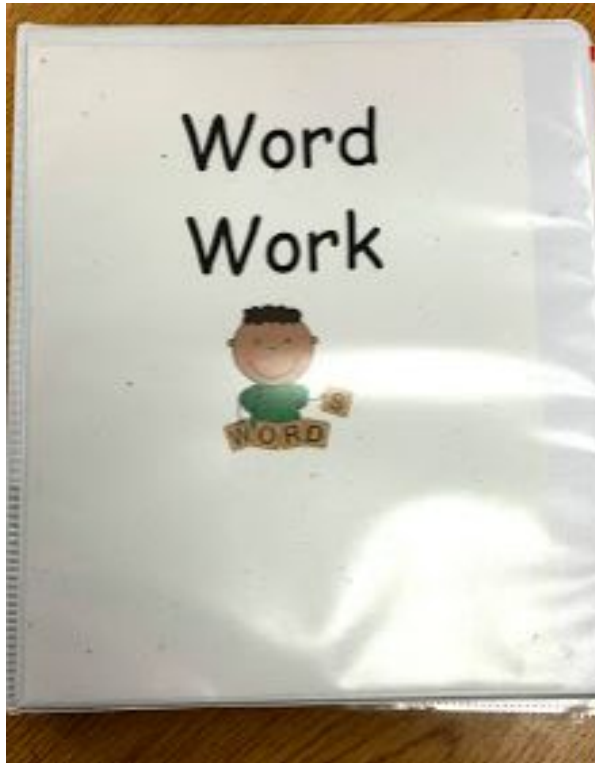
The teacher includes copies of decodable readers in the binder for students to read. You could also include poems or other fluency-related texts.

Student Reader



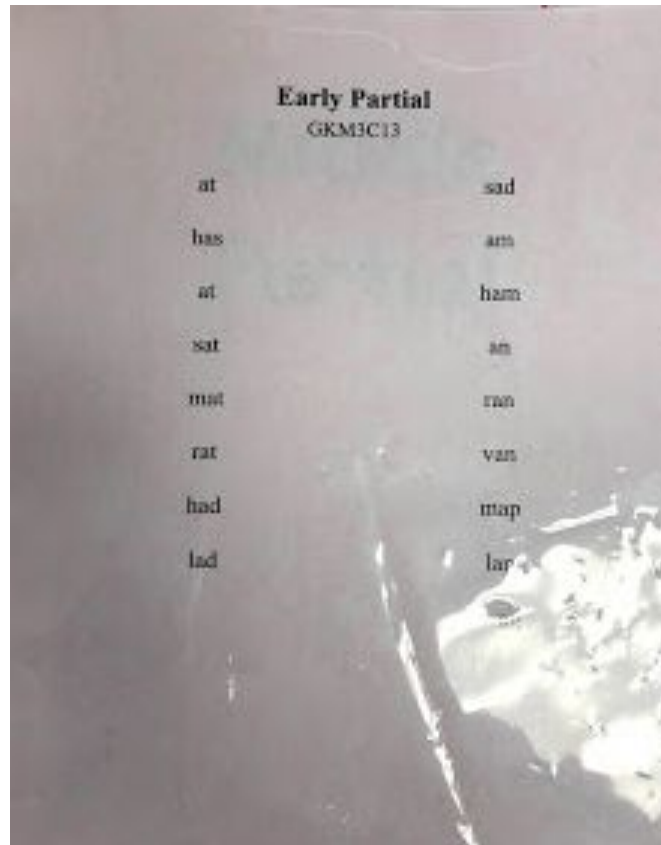
The teacher also includes a weekly task list in each binder with written and visual instructions.
